Important updates:

Things are changing so quickly at the Senior Center, it's hard to keep up. The first and most important change is that the membership voted at the last general membership meeting to allow only those fully vaccinated against Covid-19 inside the building. The vote came about after much pressure from members over concern for everyone's health and safety. Following our vote, the state announced that effective August 23, "Every person in the Washington State must wear a face covering that covers their nose and mouth when they are in a place where any person from outside their household is present, or in a place that is generally accessible to any person from outside their household." There are some exceptions to this rule, but they do not apply to gatherings at the Senior Center. Now only fully vaccinated and masked people will be admitted to the facility. Please be respectful to the staff and volunteers at the center. We are trying to work through this and appreciate your understanding.

On a much different subject, we have decided to start cooking our own congregate meals. This option has been under discussion for some time and the Board voted to move forward with this decision. It makes financial sense for us as we are responsible for the overhead and we were not making enough to cover our expenses while we leased our kitchen. We want to thank Senior Services for South Sound for their time with us. Their lease expires on September 30, 2021. They will be able to continue the Meals on Wheels program by cooking at their other facilities and delivering to their volunteers here in Shelton. We are happy to announce that Debra del Bosque will be helping by consulting and possibly cooking for us too. Needless to say, we will be looking for volunteers willing to work in the kitchen.
